

Some housing information – obviously, a critical piece of your Reunion planning – follows. Please note that you must make your own lodging reservations. Also, our Reunion runs concurrently with graduation weekend, so plan ahead.

1. The Hanover Inn is reserving 15 rooms for the Class of 1968. Reservations with a three-night minimum may be made beginning at noon EDT, June 1, 2017, the first of the month one year out from our Reunion.
2. A number of national chains have relatively new hotels in the Hanover area, including Courtyard Marriott, Element by Westin, Six South Street, Hampton Inn, Holiday Inn Express, Fairfield Inn and Suites, Residence Inn, Comfort Inn, White River Inn & Suites, and others. We've had good experiences with these hotels in the Upper Valley area. The hospitality industry standard for the earliest a reservation may be made is 365 days out from the date requested.
3. Some of you may prefer more exotic and intimate accommodations, such as a favorite B&B, the Norwich Inn, Dowd's Country Inn, the Hotel Coolidge in White Rivah, or an Upper Valley friend's guest room.
4. Also, rooms in one of the newer, air-conditioned dorms will be available. Dorm rooms for 2017 reunions are \$50 per person per night, and the price for 2018 is likely to be the same. Dorm room sign-up will not be available (and will be a separate item) until our registration packet goes out on March 1, 2018.
